Grade 7 and 8 Excursion to Launceston

Dear Parents and Carers,

On Wednesday 23 August 2023, Grade 7 and 8 students are invited to attend an excursion to Launceston and engage in collaborative learning experiences through participation in the Entombed Escape Rooms and Ten Pin Bowling.

We will leave St Marys District School (SMDS) at 9.00am and will return to school by 4.00pm. Pick up and drop off from the Fingal Valley Neighbourhood House (FVNH) will be available for students who live in Fingal and surrounding communities. As we are returning after the school day finishes, parents will need to collect their child from St Marys District School by 4.00pm.

Staff and students will be travelling by Calows Coaches. Staff attending the excursion will be Mrs Christine Waters, Mrs Claire Neyland, Mr Will Innis and Ms Erin Miller.

Students will not be required to wear school uniform; however, they must wear comfortable and appropriate clothing for physical activity, including closed-in footwear. They will need to bring a drink and a packed recess and lunch as we will be eating down at the Punch Bowl Reserve. There will be no opportunity for the purchasing of food or drinks.

Students will be divided into two groups for the activities and both groups will complete the two activities.
