- Monthly fee is a 4 week period from date of payment. Payment for January access must be made by December 17 as Keycards will not be able to be recharged between Dec 18 2025 and Jan 31 2026
- \*\* includes admin fee for update of keys

#### **PURCHASING OF CARDS**

The key card system requires cards to be programmed in the office with the data being manually transferred to the door. As this is a lengthy process the procedure for card purchases will be:

- Completion of hire agreement, presentation of appropriate CPR Certificate and payment made at the office by 1.00 p.m. Monday – Friday.
- Door access will be available at this time.
- **PLEASE NOTE:** The administration office will be closed over the school holidays and key cards will not be able to be purchased or recharged between 17<sup>th</sup> December 2025 to 31<sup>st</sup> January 2026. It is therefore recommended that those opting for the monthly plan ensure their payment for January's pool access is made prior to December 19<sup>th</sup>.

Please do not store your electronic pool access card near mobile phones as this will stop the card from working and render it unable to be reprogrammed and void of a refund.




#### **BUDDY SYSTEM**

We are required by the RLSSA to support a 2 person buddy system, to ensure in the event of an accident/emergency there is back up support by a buddy.

If you choose to swim as an individual you do so at your own risk. Your signature on the pool application key implies you acknowledge and accept this condition.

\*\* As this is an unsupervised pool, cardholders are required to have access to a mobile phone while in the pool enclosure in case of emergency.

#### **POOL COVERS**

#### Cover the pool for everyone's comfort

Summer: covers on from 6.00pm Autumn: covers on from 5.00pm Or if you are the last to be in the pool.

#### **2026 Supervised Community Swim Sessions**

The pool may not be available to keycard holders between the hours of 9.00 a.m. - 12.00 p.m. on Mondays during the summer holidays in order to allow the Community Swimming Program to operate - this information will be in the display boards at the pool.

#### LAP SWIMMERS AND LANE ROPES

Multiple Lap swimmers are entitled to rope off 2 lanes (COVID-19 requirement), Single Lap swimmers I lane adjacent to the pool wall. It is an expectation that lap swimmers can swim in this lane without interference from other pool users.



Please be aware that there is a Defibrillator and First Aid in the pool enclosure for the safety of patrons. Please ensure that this equipment is used according to your CPR & First aid training and by following the spoken instructions from the Defib machine. Report any instances of inappropriate use/vandalism to the school on 63723900 or via Facebook messenger.

### DOOR SECURITY

All pool doors must be kept closed at all times.

Take your pool key with you to the toilets/change rooms (please note: toilets and change rooms are located outside the pool enclosure). All pool key users will be issued with a toilet key. The toilet door must remain locked at all times. DO NOT LEAVE CHILDREN UNATTENDED IF LEAVING THE POOL ENCLOSURE.

Do not let others claiming to have "lost their key, left it at home, have a malfunctioning key etc" into the pool enclosure
