3 steps to plan ahead to prepare a good estate plan.

Planning ahead to protect yourself and the ones you love is easier than you think.

- ☐ **Prepare a Will** – A Will states how you would like your assets distributed when you pass away and allows you to appoint an executor (who will be the person or organisation responsible for carrying out your wishes).
- ☐ **Make an enduring power of attorney** - An enduring power of attorney allows appointed individual(s) or organisations to take care of your financial affairs if you are unable to or do not want to make those decisions.
- ☐ **Appoint an enduring guardian** - An enduring guardian is a registered document that allows you to appoint an individual(s) to make decisions about your health and wellbeing if you are unable to make those decisions.
